

Achievements for the Staff Hotels Memories Project During 2007

1. Seven general meetings, held during March to December, 2007 were attended by 81 different former residents, with between 20 and 39 people at each meeting. The typical attendance was 25.
2. The title for our book, *Memories from the Staff Hotels, Deep River, 1945-1985*, was chosen because most of the information being included in it has come from our collective memories. There are no written AECL or Staff House Club records.
3. 2000 names have been provided for the Residents' Register by about 200 people.
4. 135 stories and 35 vignettes were submitted by about 100 authors.
5. 1200 photographs were supplied by 80 people.
6. Our website has had 6200 hits since July 31. Some hundreds of names for the Register have arrived via this route.
7. Advertising the project in the Pembroke Daily Observer resulted in 2 or 3 contacts. Advertising in the Ontario Power Generation site newsletters resulted in 5 or 6 contacts.
8. About 200 people have provided book-related material during the gathering phase of the project, which was completed on Dec 31, 2007.
9. Assembling material as pages for the book is now underway. We expect to have about 275 pages.
10. The target date for having the master ready for printing is April 15, 2008.
